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TRAINERS FROM THE FINFLUENCERS PROJECT ARE READY TO TEST THE TRAINING METHODOLOGY



The FinFluencers project and its partnership, funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union, aims to design, develop, and offer to young people, aged 19-29, an online training provision to support them in making informed and confident financial decisions as economic actors, producers, consumers, professionals, entrepreneurs, and employees, considering that there is a direct positive relationship between financial literacy and the well-being of the individuals.

On the other hand, the project is also supporting its secondary target group, namely, experts, trainers, facilitators and representatives of NGOs/organizations/SMEs working and supporting young people on various topics, ensuring them guidance and support when organising and implementing courses on financial literacy. The project partnership developed a training methodology, which will be the basis of the future online training platform, developed under the project. On the other hand the methodology is also suitable for face to face training sessions, covering topics such as "Being financially literate", "Personal Finance", "Financial services", "Budgeting", "Financial Literacy and work life"



In the beginning of December 2022, the project organized a training session entitled "Train the trainer" in Athens, Greece, during which the partners brought trainers from Bulgaria, Republic of North Macedonia, Portugal and Greece, who were trained how to conduct future trainings with young people, on financial literacy in more engaging and interesting way. They were trained how to put in practice the elaborated under the project training methodology which is focusing to train young people and provide them financial literacy skills, ensuring them practical case studies and examples.

In the upcoming months- January-February 2023, the trained trainers will test the training methodology with young people in their countries, on local level.
